a unique, non-partisan community/municipal information service for residents of Keego Harbor, Orchard Lake, Sylvan Lake, and West Bloomfield.

### **Why does it exist?**

to provide information and programming that benefits residents of the four communities

### **What information?**

live coverage of local, county, and state governmental bodies as well as information from each community and community organizations

programming which fosters a sense of community, improves the lives of residents, and makes them more knowledgeable citizens and voters

programming about the specific facilities and services provided by local government

### **What are some of the programs I can watch on CVTV?**

- ◆ Community Information Service - timely graphic and text information highlighting local, state, and federal government services and facilities, including meeting agendas and synopses
- ◆ Live cablecasts of the meetings of local governmental bodies in the four Greater West Bloomfield communities, county government and state government from Michigan Government Television
- ◆ Recorded programming, such as local and county governmental meetings available online for 30 days
- ◆ Roundtable discussions and interviews, including local elected and appointed officials
- ◆ Coverage of community events in the four Greater West Bloomfield communities
- ◆ Public service announcements promoting civic involvement and governmental events, including elections
- ◆ Informational programs regarding local issues and government services
